

## Proposed Catalog Copy Change for Public Health Minor for Teacher Licensure

### Rationale

The following proposed revisions to the Public Health minor for Teacher Licensure will be beneficial for several reasons. Reducing the requirement from 24 credits to 21 credits makes this much more attainable for some students. The core courses still give the program the strength and rigor necessary but now offers more flexibility and more possible content area exposure. A 21-credit minor also aligns with the state endorsement requirements.

The proposed change includes:

Removing PUBH 3400 – School Health Methods. All students taking the minor have a teacher certification major and have a "methods" course in their major. The categories of electives have been reviewed and updated to reflect current course offerings as well as the addition of some courses that align with the state endorsement guidelines.
