Qualities of Honors Courses at Eastern Illinois University

An ideal Honors Course at Eastern Illinois University should ...

- Encourage critical and analytical thinking, and provide ample opportunity for structured reflection;
- Incorporate problem-solving skills;
- Engage students in the learning process;
- Sharpen communication skills;
- Be integrative, and connect skills and knowledge from multiple courses and experiences;
- Accentuate one-on-one interaction;
- Exhibit inquiry-based learning;
- Encourage collaboration in assignments and projects;
- Encourage intellectual curiosity and intellectual risk taking;
- Evidence openness to new ideas;
- Demonstrate pedagogical innovation and experimentation;

As appropriate to the scope and focus of the course, Honors courses should also ...

- Be interdisciplinary;
- Emphasize diversity and global learning, and encourage intercultural knowledge and competence;
- Be writing intensive;
- Emphasize service-learning and community based-learning in order to allow for real-world application of knowledge.
